# Tempting Treats

### ROLLED OAT COOKIES

Makes approx. 4 1/2 dozen



#### **INGREDIENTS**

1 cup rolled oats
1 tablespoon white sugar
1 teaspoon brown sugar
1 cube beef bouillon,
crumbled
1 tablespoon poultry

seasoning

1 tablespoon mild paprika

3/4 cup cornmeal
2 1/2 cups all-purpose
flour
1 cup boiling water
1/3 cup butter, softened
1/2 cup milk
1 egg

#### **DIRECTIONS**

Preheat the oven to 325 degrees F (165 degrees C). Grease cookie sheets.

In a bowl, stir together the oats, brown sugar, white sugar, poultry seasoning, paprika, beef bouillon, cornmeal and flour.

In a separate bowl, stir together the butter and hot water until butter melts. Stir in the milk and egg. Add mixture to dry ingredients. Mix until well blended.

(The dough will be stiff. If it is too stiff, add a bit more water. If it is too sticky, add more flour.)

On a lightly floured surface, knead the dough for a few turns. Roll out to 1/4 to 1/2 inch thickness, and cut into squares or into desired shapes using cookie cutters. Place treats about 1 inch apart on the prepared cookie sheets.

Bake for 30 to 35 minutes in the preheated oven, until lightly browned and firm. Let cool for 10 or 15 minutes. Cool, store in an airtight container at room temperature.


